## Digital Tools for the Analysis of Historical Corpora (workshop)

Whereas students trained in digital humanities often have the tools but not the texts, students of the more “traditional” humanities disciplines who research texts often lack the technical skills to use these tools. This workshop will introduce digital tools that will be taught at a beginner’s level.
